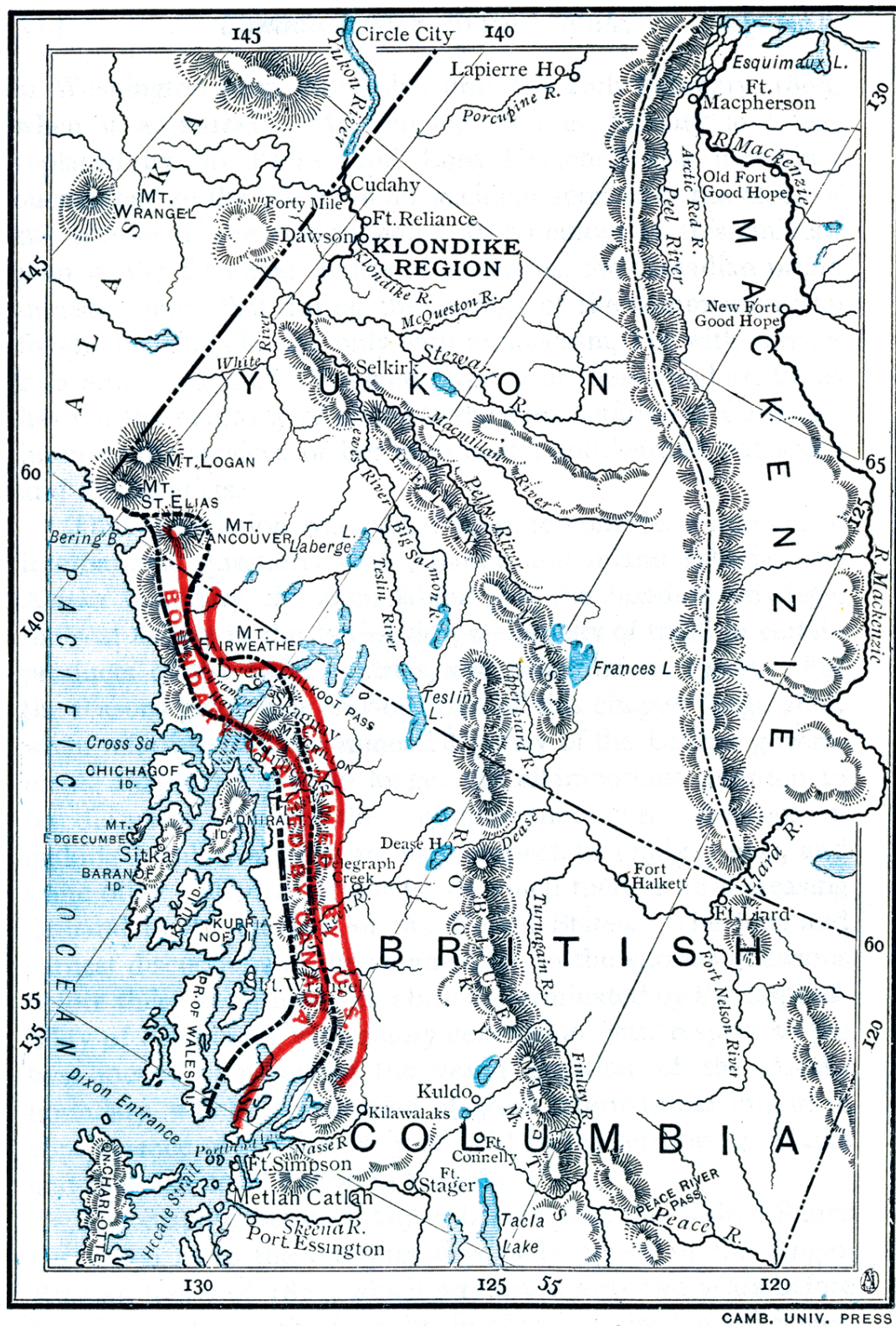

CANADA AND THE UNITED STATES.

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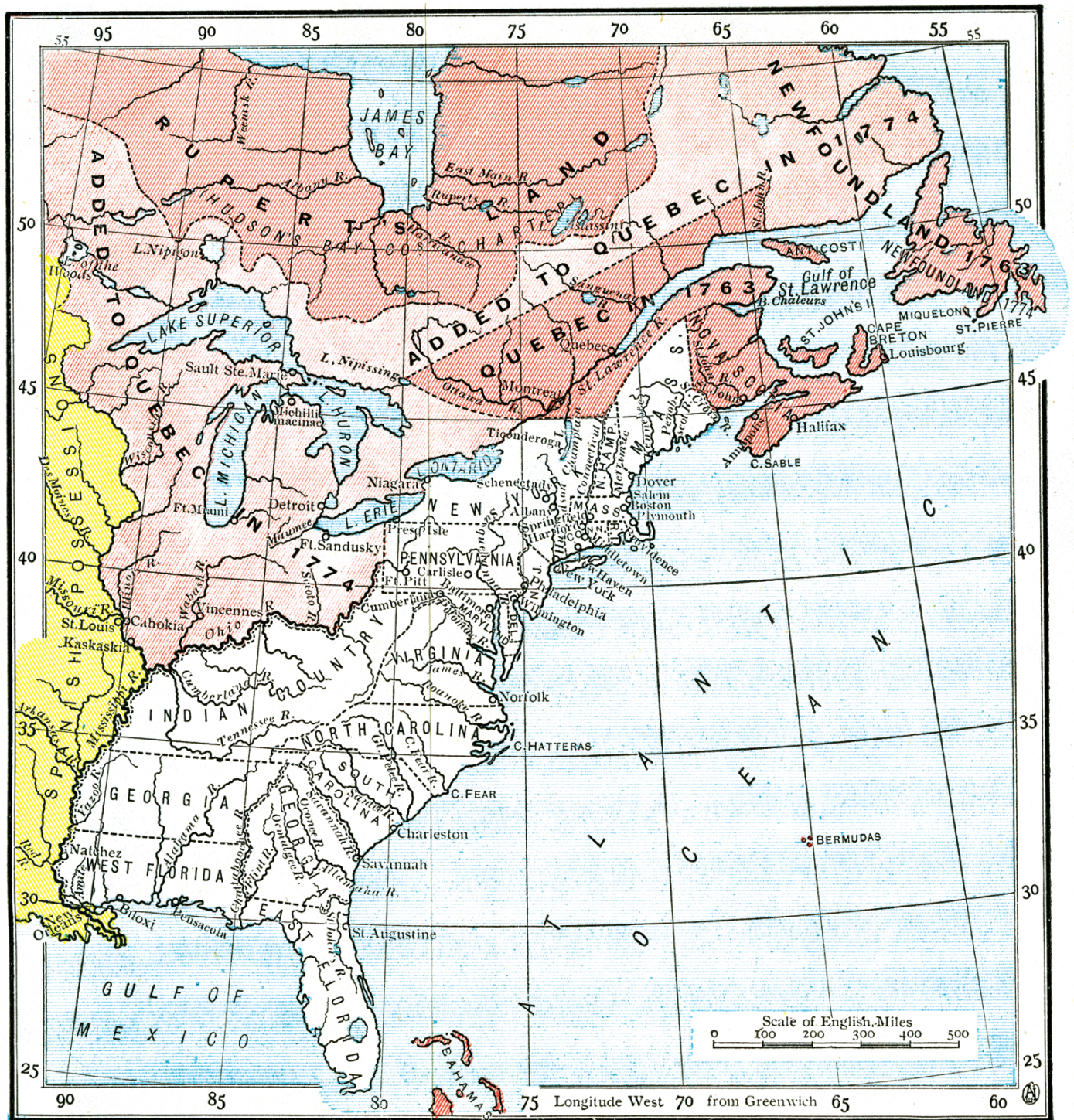

NOTE TO MAP VIII.

Since this map was drawn, two new Provinces have been formed, viz. Alberta and Saskatchewan. The Province of Alberta lies immediately to the E. of British Columbia. Its western boundary is identical with that of Alberta and Athabasca as marked in the map; its eastern boundary follows the meridian 110' W. It thus comprises the former District of Alberta and the western half of the District of Athabasca, with the westernmost portions of the Districts of Saskatchewan and Assiniboia. The Province of Saskatchewan lies immediately to the E. of Alberta. Its western boundary follows the meridian 110' W.; its eastern boundary the meridian 102' W. It thus comprises the greater part of the former Districts of Assiniboia and Saskatchewan, with almost all the eastern half of Athabasca. Both Provinces are bounded on the N. by the 60th parallel of N. latitude, and on the S. by the frontier of the United States (latitude 49' N.).

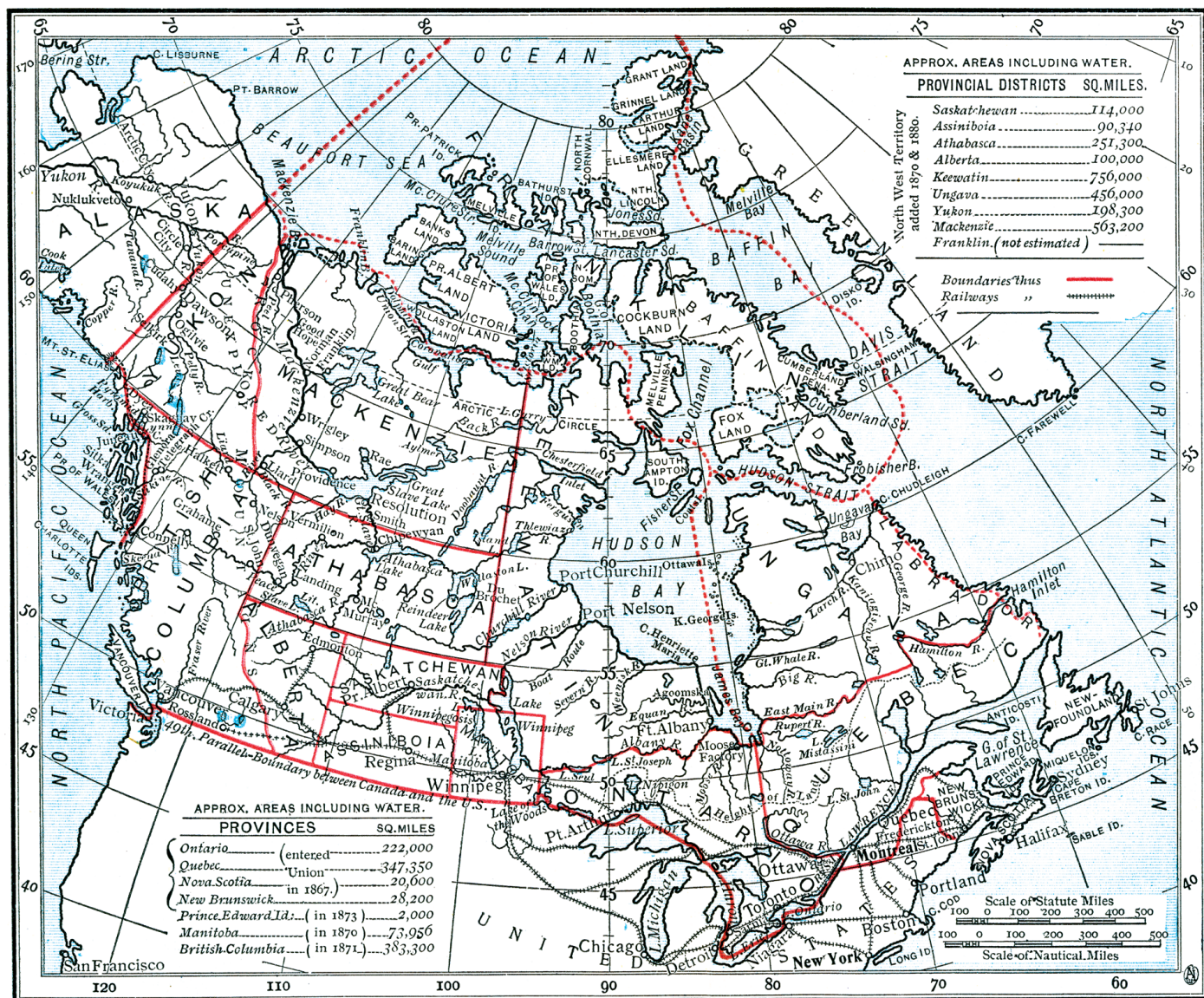
All the lands not included in the nine Provinces or the District of Yukon are now called the "North-West Territories." Those portions of the former Districts of Athabasca and Saskatchewan which lie E. of the meridian 102' W. are now merged in these Territories. Yukon is a Provincial District under separate administration.
